Two-Year Track (Full Master's Programme): This comprehensive programme provides students with a strong foundation in Human Rights and Democratic Governance, with the opportunity to specialise in specific areas. It includes 22 courses (120 ECTS credits), an internship, field activities, and a human rights laboratory.

One-Year Track (Accelerated Programme): This track is open to students who already hold a master's degree in social sciences or an equivalent field. Admitted students will complete the core curriculum of the second year along with supplementary foundational and specialisation courses. This accelerated programme covers up to 90 ECTS credits and spans 13 months.
